Along with the old town, the present day Bhubaneswar has often been illustrated as the Ekamra Khetra (Temple City). Although the modern city of Bhubaneswar was formally established only in 1948, the history of the areas in and around the present-day city can be traced to the 3rd century BCE and earlier. It is a confluence of Hindu, Buddhist and Jain heritage boasting of some of the finest Kalingan temples.



Odissi sangita is a synthesis of four classes of music, i.e. dhruvapada, chitrapada, chitrakala and panchal, described in two treatises namely, Sangita Sarani and Sangita Narayana written in the early 19th century. It owes much to Jayadev, the saint-poet, the great composer and illustrious master of classical music.


In sync with the greatest music of Odisha, the Odissi dance is said to be an effort to come near God and experience true bliss. Therefore, this dance was a legacy kept alive by the devadasis who used to dance to the recitation of hymns and bols of talas. The Odissi dance is evolved from the millennium old dance form called Mahari that used to be performed at the temple of Lord Jagannath at Puri by devadasi dancers called maharis.

Apart from the classical Odissi, Chaau is also a prominent dance form in the world of Odisha music and dance. It is the dance of warriors to the accompaniment of indigenous music instruments.

The highly Stylised Chhau dance of today follow the basic principle of the Natya Shastra of Bharat Muni and the Abhinaya Darpana of Nandikeswara. Jatra, Pala, Dashkathia, Gotipua, Naga-Medha dance are few other dance forms that form the rich history and culture of Odisha.













People still pay for professional run theatre shows and plays like Manikajodi, that ran for 380 days in 1999.



Birding


Resting on the banks of the Bay of Bengal, the state of Orissa is heaven from an ornithological standpoint. Blessed with mangrove forests and wetlands, it is home to an abundance of birdlife that undertake arduous journeys to congregate in large numbers.

In fact, Orissa harbours well over 11,00,000 birds that capitalize on the second largest lagoon of the world called Chilika Lake.

Apart from this rich brackish lake, Orissa has a mangrove forest embedded in a wildlife sanctuary called Bhitarkanika where birders have a great chance of 8 different Kingfisher species.

If birding here alone isn't enough, there's the Gahirmatha Matine Sanctuary which hosts the largest nesting of Olive Ridley turtles in the world.

With such highlights waiting to be witnessed under one tour, this one is for the bucket list.

Handloom

The mastery of the weavers has especially touched sylvan heights in tassar silk. In fact, the tassar cooperatives produce the finest quality of yarn, the popularity of which is testified by its brilliance, glaze and texture.

The attention to details from silkworm cultivation to silk weaving combine centuries of experience and modern know-how, for creating silk ties and sarees that harmonise the delicate feel with a soothing blend of colours and elegance, exquisite but comfortable.

The textiles have an individuality of their own. Bold and unusual patterns, vibrant yet subtle blend of colours, unique tie and die effects and a luxuriant texture characterize them. The State is famous for its silk ikat weaves, an intricate process (bandha) in which wrap and weft threads are first tied and then dyed, to produce the designed pattern on the loom while weaving.



Trekking


With a vast forest expanse and undulating plains, Odisha makes up for an ideal destination to attract enthusiastic trekkers.

Diverse lifestyles and social customs have shaped the musical scape of Odisha which is distinct yet soulful.



Known as the Temple City of India, Bhubaneswar is among the best tourist places to visit in Odisha. It is a classic example of history, heritage, and urbanization.


The place has marvellous temples showcasing amazing artwork, wildlife sanctuaries, and exhilarating caves.

City



Pipli – The Town Known For Handicrafts




The town is a port city and has famous beaches. Go beach hopping here, in this Odisha town and chill and relax here, on one of the beaches, on your next trip to Odisha




Talasari Beach – Relax Under The Sun Talasari

Shree Jagannath Temple: Witness the famous Rath Yatra





Simlipal National Park: Witness the famous Bengal Tiger



Located about 15 km from the Sambalpur districts, Hirakud Dam is built across the Mahanadi river.



Clothing




People


